Kelly Lake Access Area Temporary Closure For Cabin Construction

The Kelly Lake Access Area on the Kenai National Wildlife Refuge including over night camping, the Kelly Lake boat ramp, and Seven Lakes Trail parking, will be closed beginning Sunday July 5, 2009 at 8:00 PM and will re-open Tuesday, July 7, at 6:00 PM. During this time, the parking area will be occupied by work vehicles, cabin materials and heavy equipment will be in use. Seven Lakes trail users may use the adjacent Peterson Lake Access Area with an additional ½ mile walk to the ordinary trailhead. This administrative closure is required to facilitate delivery of materials and construction of a new public use cabin at Kelly Lake.
