Next Shanta Creek Fire Community Meeting Scheduled for Tuesday, July 14

Fire managers and community officials have scheduled a follow-up community meeting to continue to update residents within the Funny River Road area and others on the current status of the Shanta Creek Fire.

The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, July 14 starting at 7:00 p.m. and will be held at the Funny River Community Center located at 35850 Pioneer Access Road east of Soldotna.

Community officials, agency representatives, and members from the National Incident Management Organization (NIMO) will be on hand once again to provide residents with an update on the Shanta Creek fire situation and answer questions. Over 230 residents and others attended the Sunday's meeting to hear about current fire situation and long range outlook, community protection planning, community evacuation planning, and comments from local land managers.
